Please help!

What H₂O has achieved to date has only been possible with the financial help it has received from major funding organisations. While some funders will assist on an ongoing basis others see their contributions as the start up capital required by the charity and expect it to generate a realistic percentage of its income requirements.

While small local fundraising projects are always welcome a more regular and certain source of income is required to plan ahead and ensure the long-term success of H₂O.

As H₂O is a Christian organisation a large part of its income to date has come from Christian based sources but it is clear that the whole community whether Christian or non-Christian is benefiting from its work with young people. Parents, Grandparents or people on their own regardless of age recognise the difficulties facing young people at the present time. It is therefore hoped that ALL in the community will appreciate the work undertaken by H₂O and where practical give financial support to this exciting initiative.

A Supporters Club numbering an initial 200 is to be established where individuals or businesses will subscribe monthly amounts of £10, £15, or £25. This will be received where applicable under the gift aid scheme to enable H₂O to reclaim at least a further 28 pence for every pound given. The Supporters Club will be given the opportunity to both review our work to date and to explore new and alternative ways to achieve the objectives of H₂O. Smaller amounts from £2 per month or one off amounts will be equally welcome and can also be received under the gift aid scheme.
